FOOD GRADE SOYBEAN QUALITY SPECIFICATIONS

Seed Quality and Appearance	Canada Grade No. 1 Suitable for end user purposes (food consumption) Clean and bright; free of dirt tagging and weed staining. Must be of such purity, odor, seed size and visual quality to meet end-user requirements for human consumption. 0% tolerance of corn and Pokeweed stain.
Moisture	Maximum 14.5%: Moisture discounts at time of delivery apply.
Purity	99.0% purity of type less than 0.5% cocklebur, nightshade or admixture that is considered by WEL as inseperable.
Total Damage Heat Damage	2.0 % includes green beans, insect damage moldy, heat damaged (rancid)
Heated	Nil
Dockage + Foreign Material	Maximum 2.0% Dockage and FM deducted from delivered weight. FM= other grains, <u>inseparable seeds</u> such as cocklebur, ragweed, stones, or Sclerotia. Dockage /FM assessed by CGC regulation
Downey mildew	Less than 1% contamination Less than 0.1 % sclerotia
Cleanout	Maximum 15% * Cleanout is assessed by the buyer as material falling though a 13/64slotted screen after dockage has been removed. Discounts to apply above 15%. Rejection at 25% cleanout
Genetic Modification (GMO)	Seed must test negative to a 98% assurance level and each delivery pass an acceptance strip test.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Delivered soybeans must meet the quality specifications outlined
2. Grower must submit all document requirements to be eligible for the premium.
3. **If the soybeans are delivered in the rain or the snow, no premium will be paid.**
