Testing for Falling number will done on a random basis at the beginning of deliveries. If falling number is low on initial samples, then testing may be done on additional or all samples.

Samples containing kernels affected by mildew are graded according to the degree of soundness definition as reflected in the standard or guide samples for each grade." CGC Grain Grading Guide - Wheat
